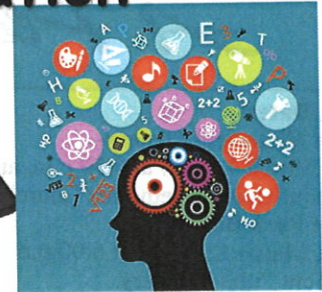

Dear Parents,

Fremont Elementary School is currently enrolling Kindergarten students for next school year! We welcome you to stop by school during the hours of 8:30 a.m.-2:00 p.m. to enroll your child. While enrollment will continue to occur throughout the summer months, it is most helpful if students enroll as soon as possible as this allows us to plan properly with accurate numbers of students. To assist us with our planning, we ask that you complete and return the form at the bottom of this letter.

To be enrolled, children **must** be 5 years old on, or before, August 1st, 2024. At the time of enrollment, please bring the following items with you:

- Birth certificate
 - Immunization record
 - Proof of residency (if new family to FCS Corporation)
- (Note: Your child will need a new physical exam for Kindergarten. You may pick up the exam form when you register your child.)

It is not necessary to bring your child when you register, as Kindergarten screening will take place in May. At the time of enrollment, you will schedule for a time for your child to attend screening event.
