

**June 28, 2011**

*The special meeting of the Fremont Town Council was called to order by President Steve Brown at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 28, 2011.*

***Silent roll call:** Steve Brown, Joe Thomas, Kay Clark, and Steve Vaughn were present. Linda Fulton was absent. Mary K. Parsons, IAMC/MMC/CPFA, Clerk-Treasurer, and Town Manager Chris Snyder, also attended.*

***Others attending were:** Jim Measel with WLKI, Casey Erwin with DLZ, Thane Knox with E & B, and a representative with Parrish Excavating.*

*First order of business was to open the bids on the Downtown Revitalization project:*

*President Steve Brown entertained a motion to award the street project for 2011 to E& B Paving for \$157,531.25. Councilmember Joe Thomas made the motion to award the bid to E&B Paving for \$157,531.25 and to allow President Brown to sign the necessary paperwork to enter in the contract, second by Councilmember Steve Vaughn, all in favor.*

*Judge Hagerty made a request through Clerk Treasurer Parsons to purchase three Radar units. One would be for \$1,200.00, the other two would be for \$1,684.00 each. This would come from the Records Perpetuation Fund and there would be a lease agreement signed with the respective officers who would be using the units. Councilmember Joe Thomas made the motion to approve the purchase, second by Councilmember Kay Clark, all in favor.*

*Town Manager Snyder wanted to let the Council know that a storm sewer in Blackman Prairie has collapsed and will need repaired. There is the possibility of this repair costing up to \$30,000.00. He will keep them informed. Also, if anyone would like to ride in the parade as a representative for the Stebuen County Economic Development Committee, please let Chris know.*

*Councilmember Kay Clark moved to adjourn the meeting, second by Councilmember Steve Vaughn, all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 3:10 p.m.*
