Approval of Minutes: *Councilmember Joe Thomas, moved to approve the minutes from the previous meeting, second by Councilmember Lon Keyes, all in favor.*

Approval of Claims, Payroll, Comp time, Fund Report and Appropriation Report:

Councilmember Steve Vaughn moved to approve claims, payroll, comp time, Fund and Appropriation reports as presented, second by Councilmember Linda Fulton, all in favor.

Old Business:

Utility Credits: *Councilmember Lon Keyes moved to approve the credits as presented, second by Councilmember Linda Fulton, all in favor.*
