Music Fest Donation and closing of Streets: Councilmember Joe Thomas moved for the Town to donate \$1,500.00 to the Chamber of Commerce to pay for added security during Music Fest and to close Streets from Toledo Street to North Street and Spring Street to Tolford Street for the festival, second by Councilmember Steve Vaughn, all in favor.

Resolution 2018-2: A Resolution of the Fremont Town Council for the deduction from assessed valuation for the occupation of the eligible vacant building for commercial or industrial purposes-EZ-Flo, International, Inc. Councilmember Steve Vaughn moved to approve Resolution 2018-2, second by Councilmember Linda Fulton, all in favor. Councilmember Lon Keyes moved to waive the second reading of Resolution 2018-2, second by Councilmember Joe Thomas, all in favor.

SCEDC Contract: Councilmember Linda Fulton moved to approve the Steuben County Economic Development Commission contract in the amount of \$13,687.00, second by Councilmember Lon Keyes, all in favor.

REPORTS:

Court: Report was submitted, Judge Snyder stated that Cameron Memorial Hospital does not award Beautification Awards anymore and asked the Town if they wanted to continue this within the Town of Fremont. Councilmember Joe Thomas moved to approve awarding a home in Fremont two times a year by placing a sign in their yard for recognition, second by Councilmember Linda Fulton, all in favor.

Fire: Report was submitted. Chief Hufnagle was absent. Chief Hufnagle submitted a quote to get an extractor for turn out gear in the amount of \$7,300.00. Councilmember Lon Keyes moved to make this purchase, second by Councilmember Joe Thomas, all in favor.

Police: Report was submitted, Marshal Patterson asked for approval to advertise for a new police officer to replace one leaving. Councilmember Lon Keyes moved to approve the advertising contingent on a possible opening, second by Councilmember Joe Thomas, all in favor.

Street: Report was submitted, Superintendent Olds asked to purchase new tires for the 2016 Ford truck. Three quotes were submitted. Superintendent Olds asked to purchase locally from Powers Automotive. Councilmember Joe Thomas moved to purchase the tires from Powers Automotive in the amount of \$829.04, second by Councilmember Linda Fulton, all in favor.

Water: Report was submitted. Superintendent Sattison said that Sam Samuels asked for water lines to extend out to his property by the truck by-pass. Councilmember Lon Keyes moved to approve authorizing DLZ to prepare bids for the waterline, second by Councilmember Linda Fulton, all in favor. Superintendent Sattison also added that the new locator will be a very useful tool. Next week the company will be coming up to demonstrate how to use it.

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Wastewater: Report was submitted. Superintendent Humbarger was absent. Superintendent Humbarger asked to purchase tires for the Boom truck in the amount of \$1,050.00 from Miller Body Shop. Councilmember Joe Thomas moved to make this purchase, second by Councilmember Lon Keys, all in favor.

Park: report submitted. Neil Ledet stated that they are having a hard time buying small equipment for the park from vendors. They require either a credit card or PO number. They are trying to find a way to make these purchases a little easier.

Councilmember Lon Keyes moved to adjourn the meeting, second by Councilmember Linda Fulton, all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
