The Public Hearing was opened by Linda Fulton, Town Council President and then turned over to Becky Maggart, Nuisance Enforcement Officer. The purpose of the Public Hearing was a continuance from a nuisance violation at 60 W 5th St., Fremont, IN 46737. Becky Maggart, Nuisance Enforcement Officer said the property was in compliance and recommended a dismissal with no fines. Councilmember Dr. William Stitt motioned to dismiss as presented, second by Councilmember Barry Wilcox, all in favor.

Town Council President, Linda Fulton, closed the Public Hearing at 4:31 and the regular council meeting opened.

Approval of Minutes- *Councilmember Scott Glendening made a motion to approve the May minutes, second by Councilmember Ashlee Hoos, all in favor.*

Approval of Claims, Payroll, Comp Time, Fund Report and Appropriation Report- *Councilmember Ashlee Hoos moved to approve claims, payroll, comp time, Fund and Appropriation as presented, second by Councilmember Dr. William Stitt, all in favor.*

OLD BUSINESS:

DLZ Updates- *Todd Thurber from DLZ said API was working on the storm drain on Prairie Lane, and has submitted Pay App 3 for the street project of \$244,608.54. Councilmember Ashlee Hoos motioned to pay as presented, second by Councilmember Scott Glendening, all in favor. Todd Thurber from DLZ also said that they are in discussion with the Steuben County Drainage Board about the flooding in Blackman Prairie. Discussion followed.*

NEW BUSINESS:

Utility Credits- Councilmember Barry Wilcox made a motion to approve the credits as presented, second by Councilmember Ashlee Hoos, four in favor. Councilmember Scott Glendening abstained.

Authorization to prepare easement paperwork- Council President Linda Fulton said there are two main sewer lines that we need easements for that run across private property. Councilmember Barry Wilcox motioned to approve to start the process of preparing the paperwork for the easements, second by Councilmember Dr. William Stitt, all in favor.

SCEDC for 2027- Council President asked council to approve the agreement with Steuben County Economic Development for 2027 for \$14,400, which is the same as last year. Councilmember Dr. William Stitt motioned to approve as presented, second by Councilmember Barry Wilcox, all in favor.

Baker Tilly Agreement- Council President Linda Fulton presented the agreement with Baker Tilly. Councilmember Ashlee Hoos motioned to approve as presented, second by Councilmember Scott Glendening, all in favor.

Resignation- Council President Linda Fulton said that John Nigro has submitted his immediate resignation from the Plan Commission. Linda Fulton said this is a council appointment and asked that we send an alert out to see who may be interested. Councilmember Dr. William Stitt motioned to approve as presented, second by Councilmember Scott Glendening, all in favor.

REPORTS:

Fire: Report was submitted. Town Clerk Treasurer, Mary K. Parsons asked council to approve four storage containers that will be used for training for \$1,800 each. These will be set up in a house format. This will be paid out of the special donation fund. Councilmember Barry Wilcox motioned to approve as presented, second by Councilmember Ashlee Hoos, all in favor.

Police: Report was submitted. Town Clerk Treasurer, Mary K. Parsons asked Council to approve a new printer for the police department for \$1,995. Councilmember Barry Wilcox motioned to approve the purchase as presented, second by Councilmember Ashlee Hoos, all in favor.

Zoning: Report was submitted. Nothing to add.

Street: Report was submitted. Nothing to add. Town Council President, Linda Fulton, wanted to thank the Street Department for all the hard work and efficiency with removing the brush from the storm. Councilmember Barry Wilcox also said he liked seeing everyone working together.

Water: Report was submitted. Nothing to add.

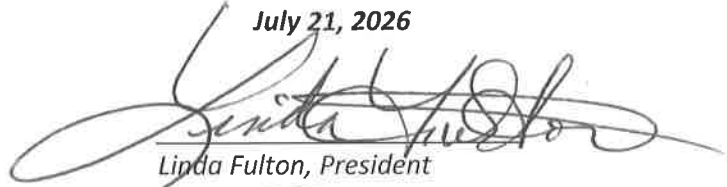

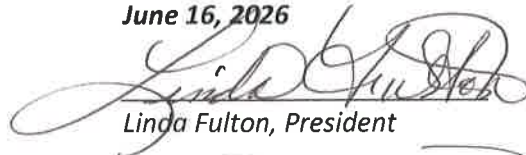
Hire Town Employee- Councilmember Ashlee Hoos made a motion to hire Zachary VanDusen for the Street department and Brent Henderson for a floater position to be used between street, water and wastewater, second by Councilmember Dr William Stitt, all in favor.

Vistula Trail- The trail project has been in the works for approximately 10 years. The farm lease on the property that the Town owns is done now so we are able to proceed with the project. A lot of the survey work has been completed. Councilmember Barry Wilcox made a motion to allow Kurt to start the paperwork to work with the school, second by Councilmember Scott Glendening, all in favor.

Wastewater Truck purchase – The Wastewater department would like to replace their 2008 truck. Town Manager Tony Shook had reached out to 5 different dealerships and had not received a firm quote back yet. He asked for authorization of up to \$40,000 for a truck purchase and to also pay for the truck with a check when picking it up. Councilmember Dr William Stitt made the motion to approve the purchase of a truck not to exceed \$40,000 and allow payment, second by Councilmember Scott Glendening, all in favor.
